

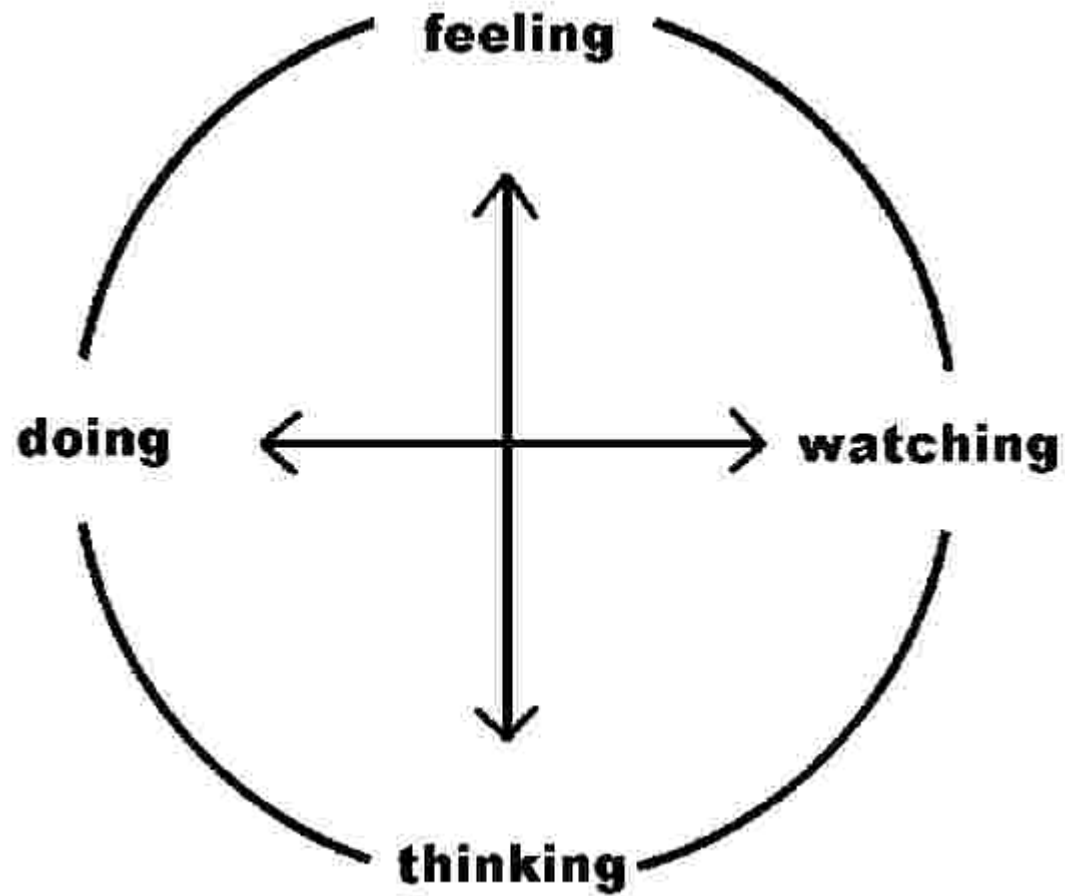

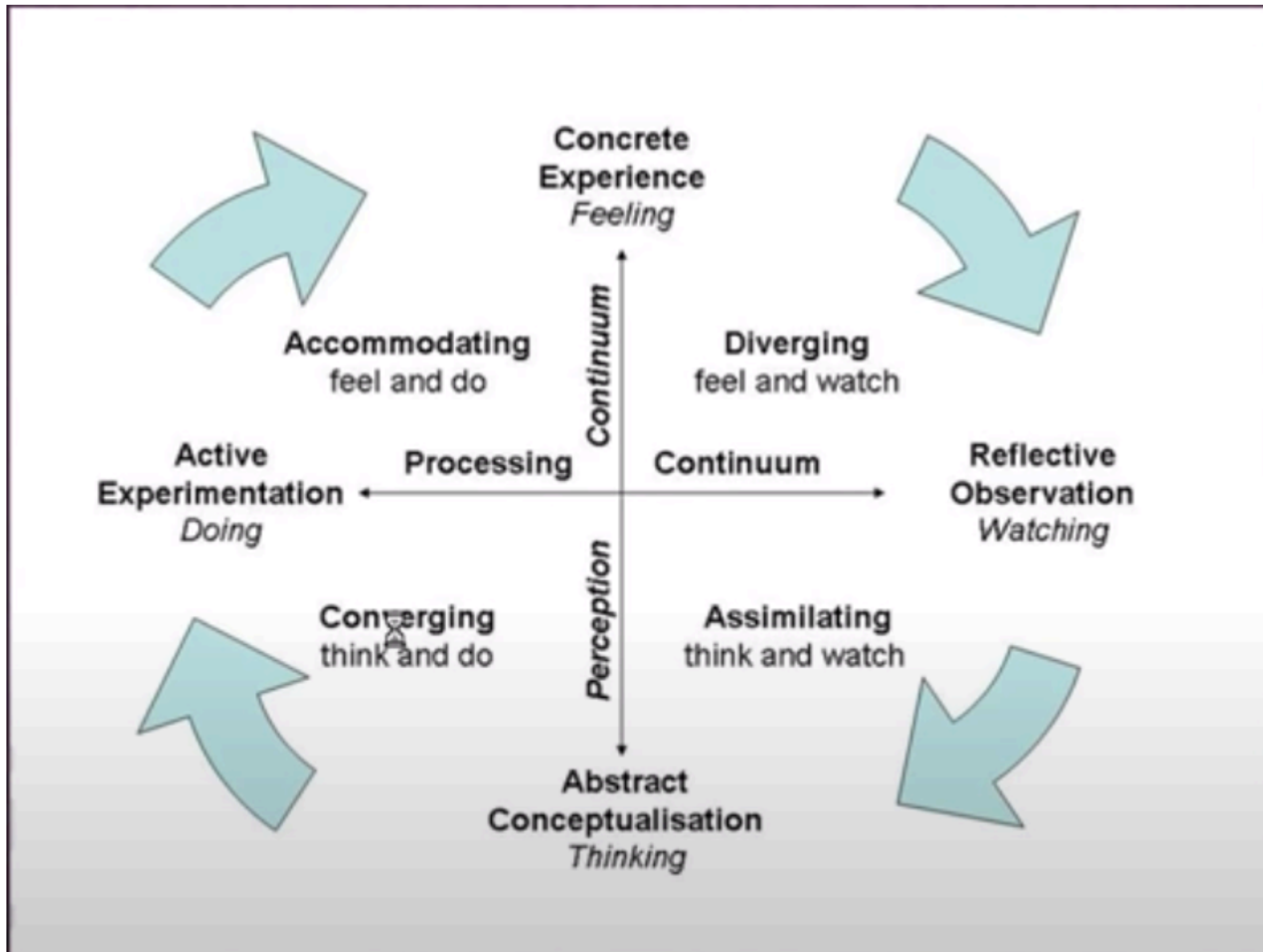
Learning

The questionnaire

Statements

Applies to me in general? Yes/No

Statements are linked to dimensions (in this case: learning styles)

Dimensions: a label for a coherent group of characteristics

There is always a “mix” of the available styles with certain accents

The categorization is not a goal, but a tool for reflection

- Task (what you have to do)
- Individual (who you are: personality, skills, ...)
- Situation (where you are, context)
